Las Vegas variety performer Donny Davis dead at 43

Donny Davis, a Las Vegas showman and impersonator who performed with acts like Britney Spears and Miley Cyrus, has died at age 43.

According to TMZ, Davis was [found in his hotel room](#) Tuesday, but a cause of death hasn't been determined yet.

A source told the gossip website that Davis was "partying" at a casino prior to the discovery of his body.

Davis was a frequent guest on "Chelsea Lately" with Chelsea Handler and was a go-to performer for a number of pop divas and variety acts when they toured Las Vegas, including Mariah Carey, Britney Spears and Seth McFarland.

He was also a regular performer and host at Beacher's Madhouse where he produced a variety show.

"Donny broke barriers in the little people community and was an inspiration to his peers. He will be missed terribly but his legacy and the impact he had on those who loved him will live on forever," Jeff Beacher told TMZ.
